



Romans 8:22-27


For we know that all creation has been **groaning** as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time. And we believers also groan, even though we have the Holy Spirit within us as a foretaste of future glory, for we long for our bodies to be released from sin and suffering. ... And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words. And the Father who knows all hearts knows what the Spirit is saying, for the Spirit pleads for **us** believers in harmony with God's own will.

Survival Brain – Fight, Flight, Freeze Emotional Brain – 80% from body to brain Rational Brain – Analysis, Meaning, Words


Limbic System
emotional behavior




An Overwhelmed Emotional Brain

A person may be caught up in excessive, unmanageable, or overwhelming emotions that could be either positive or negative for which they have no words. Quite literally, they are speechless. This my lead to responses on a scale from inappropriate physical outbursts to "freezing" or disassociation.

The Spirit inhabits our Emotional Brain

In our depths with the Spirit of God

griefs...

Trauma

The Spirit of God is there, present to our deepest pains and grieves, and giving them a voice that God hears.

Comfort and Intercession

The Spirit of God **feels with us.** In times of trauma, grief, ecstasy, depression, anxiety, rage — when we have no words, when we are disconnected with ourselves and with others — the Holy Spirit is our Helper, our comforter and advocate.

"You will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. **His peace** [shalom] **will guard your hearts** [refuge] and minds as you live in Christ Jesus [presence]." Philippians 4:7

Blessings of a Truly Present God

2 Corinthians 1:3-4

God is the Father of mercies and the God of all comfort.

He comforts us in all our tribulation and trauma, in our grief and fear.

The Holy Spirit dwells in our deepest emotional spaces where we have no words, and he groans with us, and he holds us to his heart.

There will come a time when because the Spirit of God's comfort – his peace, his presence, and his protection – has healed us, we will be able to comfort others who are experiencing their own times of trouble and trauma.

Those who are deeply wounded will be healed and they, in turn, will become wounded healers sharing God's love, and light, and life with others.
