contentment: more than a feeling

<u>Gk</u>: αὐτάρκης

The word translated "content" (autarkēs) is widely used by Greek philosophers to denote a self-sufficiency, an inner freedom not dependent on the ups and downs of life.

Paul's theology arose from his lived experiences with Jesus




nothing could separate him from the love of God in Christ Jesus... (Romans 8:35-39)

The love of God is evidenced by God's faithful presence in our lives.




The purpose of life is a life lived in relationship with Jesus.
